WE BELIEVE --

The Bible is the inspired and only infallible and authoritative Word of God **(2 Timothy 3:16)**.

That in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth **(Matthew 1:23; Luke 1:31,35)**; in His sinless life **(Hebrews 7:26; 1 Peter 2:22)**; in His miracles **(Acts 2:22; 10:38)**; in His vicarious and atoning death **(1 Corinthians 15:3; 2 Corinthians 5:21)**; in His bodily resurrection from the dead **(Matthew 28:6; Luke 24:39; 1 Corinthians 4)**; in His ascension to the right hand of the Father **(Acts 1:9, 11; 2:33; Philippians 2:9-11; Hebrews 1:3)**; in His personal, future return to the earth in Power and Glory to rule for a thousand years **(Revelation 20:4)**.

In the Blessed Hope, the soon return of Christ to receive His bride at His coming **(1 Thessalonians 4:16, 17; Titus 2:13; 1 Corinthians 15:51,52)**.

In the fall and sinfulness of man and that the only means of being cleansed from sin is through repentance and faith in the blood of Christ **(John 14:6)**.

Regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential to personal salvation **(Titus 3:5)**.

In Divine Healing of the human body provided through the redemptive work of Christ on the Cross in answer to believing prayer **(1 Peter 2:24)**.
